AWARDED BY: Chief of Staff, AFP

AWARDED TO: Officers of the AFP

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Eminently meritorious and valuable service in a position of major responsibility.
- 2. The accomplishment of duty should have been completed prior to submitting a recommendation or, if the person being recommended has been transferred prior to completion; the accomplishment must have progressed to what may clearly be determined to be exceptional or significant.
- 3. The Officer must have a minimum of six (6) months in the position.
- 4. For Command Positions, the Officer must belong to the upper 25% of commanders when compared to other commanders of the unit.
- 5. For Staff Positions, the Officer must have introduced major innovations and systems.

REQUIREMENTS:



- Honorable performance of duty in a position of major responsibility not warranting the criteria for the Distinguished Service Star award with at least a TO rank of 06 for Officers and ranks E-8 to E-10 for Senior NCOs.
- 2. Must not be relieved for cause.



REQUIREMENTS:

- 2. Performance or acts of heroism involving risk of life under conditions other than those of conflict with the enemy (i.e risk of life from saving another individual from drowning, burning building, burning/sinking ship).

SILVER WING MEDAL (SWM)





AWARDED BY: Chief of Staff, AFP, Area & Major Service Commanders, AFPWSSUs, Div/Separate Brigade or Equivalent in the PAF and PN and Ucs

AWARDED TO: Military personnel of the AFP

REQUIREMENTS:

Meritorious achievement while participating in an aerial flight and single act of merit or for <u>participation in sustained operational activities against the enemy while</u> in an aerial flight.

MILITARY MERIT MEDAL (MMM)



AWARDED BY: Chief of Staff AFP, Area and Maj Service Comdrs, AFPWSSUs, Division/Separate Brigade or equivalent in the PAF and PN and Major Subordinate Unit Commanders with TO Rank of Brigadier General or Higher

AWARDED TO: Military personnel of the AFP

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Heroic or meritorious achievement for service not involving participation in combat, in connection with military operations against an enemy of the Philippines
- 2. Single act of meritorious service either in a duty/responsibility or in direct support of military operations
- 3. The required achievement or service for award of MMMis less than that required for award for DSS; nevertheless, should be accomplished with distinction
- 4. It may be awarded posthumously to members of the AFP who, while serving in any capacity with the AFP, are killed in action by an enemy after having performed meritorious service to the AFP.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Demonstrated exemplary efficiency, devotion and loyalty to duty assignments.
- 2. Five(5) Letters of Commendation of different accomplishments and within the command line are convertible to one MCM.

WOUNDED PERSONNEL MEDAL (WPM)





AWARDED BY: Comdrs of Subordinate Units of Maj Svc down to Battalion Comdrs or its equivalent in the PAF and PN and UCs. In case of combat patient evacuated to AFP hospitals, the CO is authorized to award

AWARDED TO: Military and civilian personnel of the AFP

REQUIREMENTS:

- For having been wounded in action against an enemy of the Philippines or as a direct result of an act of the enemy, provided such wound necessitates treatment of a medical officer.
- 2. For having been killed in action against an enemy of the Philippines or as a direct result of an act of the enemy.

ARMED FORCES CONDUCT MEDAL (AFCM)





AWARDED BY: Maj Svc Comdrs, UCs, AFPWSSUs, Regional Commands, Div/Brigade and /or Equivalent unit

AWARDED TO: Enlisted personnel of the AFP

REQUIREMENTS: Must have earned two (2) successive enlistment terms with no record of punishment, convection or derogatory information whatsoever.





- 2. Personnel who have no formal training but performed AGS functions for at least two (2) years.

CIVILIAN PERSONNEL

Those who have graduated from formal courses related to administrative functions and in-service training and seminars, and have performed activities in the Adjutant's Office for at least two (2) years.

REQUIREMENTS PER LEVEL:

a. Have satisfactorily completed the Basic Airborne Course prescribed by GHQ AFP and Major Service Training Directive.

b. Have performed five (5) parachutist jumps

2. Senior Parachutist Badge

a. Have satisfactorily completed an Advanced Airborne (Jumpmaster) Course as prescribed by GHQ AFP or Major Service Training Directives.

b. Have performed at least thirty (30) parachute jumps of which five (5) are simulated combat (tactical) jumps with combat equipment and at least two (2) night jumps.

3. <u>Master Parachutist badge</u>

a. Have satisfactorily completed the Advanced Airborne (Jumpmaster) Course as prescribed by GHQ AFP, or Major Service Training Directive.

b. Have performed as Jumpmaster at least one (1) combat jump.

c. Have performed at least sixty-five (65) parachute jumps of which twenty (20) are simulated combat (tactical) jumps with combat equipment, and at least four (4) night jumps, and at least two(2) combat jumps.

Corresponding Honorary Badges may be awarded to all other military personnel from the PNP,BJMP, BFP, PAF, PN and PCG who have been assigned in units engaged in combat, combat support and combat service support operations for at least one cumulative year regardless of duty assignment or position.
- 4. Corresponding Honorary Badges may be awarded to military forces/personnel of friendly foreign nations.



ELECTION DUTY BADGE





AWARDED BY: Chief of Staff, AFP

AWARDED TO: ROTC Cadets/Cadettes and AFP personnel who were or will be duly deputized by COMELEC for election duties

REQUIREMENTS: Meritorious service rendered during the conduct of voting exercises thereby greatly contributing to the honest, orderly and peaceful elections.

INSPECTOR GENERAL'S SERVICE (IGS) BADGE





AWARDED BY: TIG, AFP

AWARDED TO: IGS officers and enlisted personnel of the AFP.

- 1. He must belong to IGS.
- 2. He must be included in the IGS Eligibility List.
- 3. Officers and EP who have taken IGS training and performing IGS function.



AWARDED BY: The Commanding General, PAF

- 3. Copy of last medical examination conducted by a flight surgeon within six months from the date of application
- 4. Advancement in RATSG Aeronautical Badge Requirements for the advancement of RATSG Aeronautical rating to Senior and Command



MARKSMANSHIP BADGE





AWARDED BY: Major Service Commanders/Unified Commands, AFPWSSUs, Regional Commands, Divisions/Brigades and equivalent units in the PAF and PN

AWARDED TO: Officers, enlisted personnel, trainee and cadets of the AFP

REQUIREMENTS: For ability and proficiency in the handling of arms. Initially, the badge and the additional bar shall be awarded to military personnel who may acquire any qualification in the marksmanship training. And for each qualification, an additional bar shall be attached to the badge. The bar shall denote the weapon and corresponding degree of qualification which may either be as marksman, sharpshooter or an expert.

AVIONICS/AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE OFFICER SPECIALTY BADGE



AWARDED BY: Commanding General, PAF

AWARDED TO: PAF Officers

- 1. Must be designated commander of a large consolidated maintenance unit.
- 2. Must have a primary AFSC of 4316 and 3216
- 3. Must have a minimum of 12-month experience in aerospace maintenance director assignment
- 4. Must have completed an Avionics/Aircraft Maintenance Staff Course or Senior Professional Military education desired
- 5. Grade spread is from Lt. Colonel (O-5) to Colonel (O-6)





- 2. For service and participation in law enforcement, military and civic action operations in the islands comprising Mindanao, waters immediately adjacent thereto for a period of at least six (6) months.

UNITED NATIONS SERVICE MEDAL & RIBBON






